- Your son/daughter then spends 4 weeks in his/her exchange partner's home and goes to school there (MARCH).




#### Exchange Objectives

- Developing independence and self-confidence;
- Developing intercultural competency by <u>living the day to</u> day life of a French teenager;
- Developing competency in French Language, and interest in other languages.




#### When is the exchange taking place?

French students in Kelowna:
October 3rd-November 1st 2020
Canadian students in France:
March 13th-April 10th 2021
(includes spring break)



IMPORTANT: Have highly demanding courses scheduled during first semester!!!!

#### What is the cost?



- Approximately \$2000 which include a return flight from Kelowna to Lyon and a chaperone both ways;
- Flights are usually around \$1600;
- Travel Insurance is around \$100;
- Most other expenses should be covered by host family except for spending expenses while away.

#### Key Ingredients to a Successful Exchange

- Willing to be flexible and adapt to different social environments;
- Being open-minded and curious about cultural differences at school, at home and everywhere else;
- Welcoming new experiences outside your comfort zone.




#### Three basic aspects of an exchange

- Welcoming your partner: students will share similar interests and will be different.
- Sharing your lifestyle and including your partner in your daily activities.
- Fully participating in activities (school, home, ...); providing a helping hand.



### Timeline

- March 13th: Deadline for Applications to be emailed & printed;
- May 10th-May 30th: selection of French candidates and twinning; you will receive your partner's information via email end of May/beginning of June
- June 8th: Meeting #1 with parents and students, re: forms; flights, necessary documents, questions/concerns;
- September 29th: Meeting #2 with parents and students, re: French students arrival; all documents submitted;
- October 3rd: French students arrival;
- November1st: French students' departure;
- November 30th: Flights & Travel Insurance are purchased;
- January: Meeting #3 to be announced, re: required forms
- March: Meeting #4 to be announced,re: pre-departure information;
- March 16th 2019: Departure to Lyon;
- April 13th 2019: Return to Kelowna.
